Laos	Participatory Development Training Centre (PADETC)	Media and Young People as Rights Advocates	This project assists the Laos Government and civil society organisations to promote a better understanding and application of policies and legislation associated with land titles and sustainable land/natural resource use.	\$90,000 AUD

It improves community understanding through education and capacity building, which leads to decreased stigmatisation. It also assists civil society organisations and public institutions to better respond to the spread of HIV/AIDS as proposed by the United Nations General Assembly Special Session on AIDS.	\$70,000 AUD

It also increases access to legal advice for LGBT people who are victims of discrimination.	\$99,600 AUD
